Objectives:

- To understand whether students have acquired the appropriate knowledge attitudes & skills to become self-reliant.
- To analysis whether curriculum design emphasizes on development of professional skills.
- To enable redesigning & restructuring of curriculum towards improvement in attainment of graduate attributes.

Methodology:

Step 1: Creation of Google forms

Framing of a structured Questionnaire to assess the attainment of graduate attributes using 5 point scale (5 – Strongly agree, 4 - Agree, 3 – Can't Say, 2- Disagree, 1- Strongly Disagree)

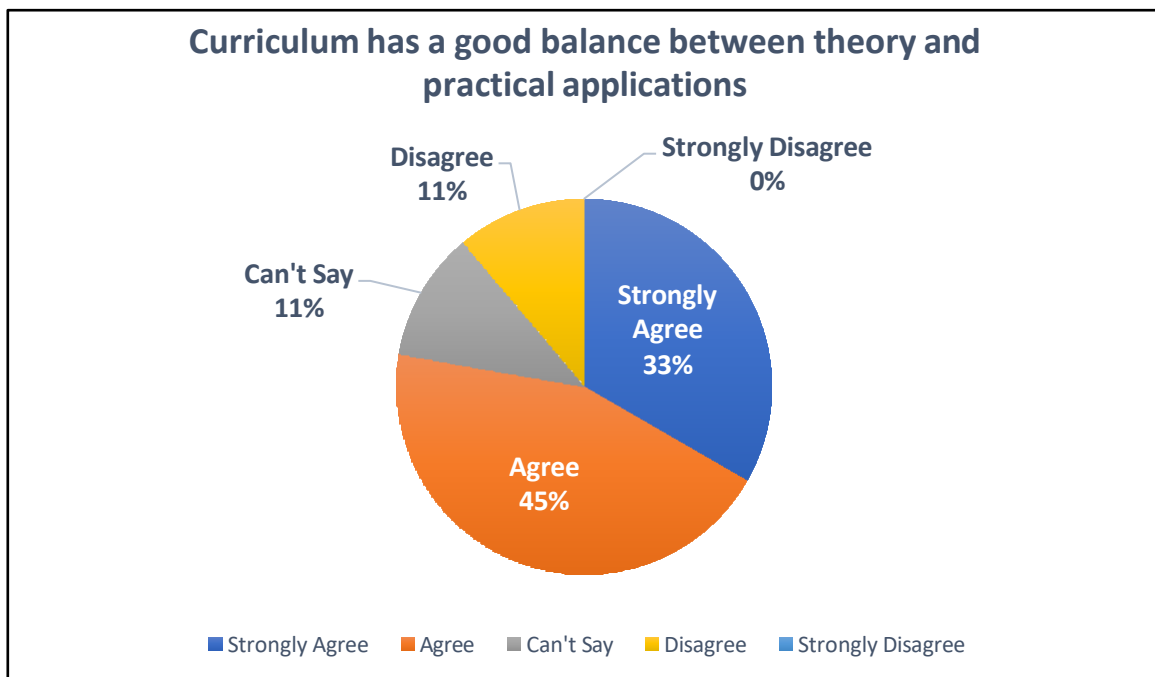
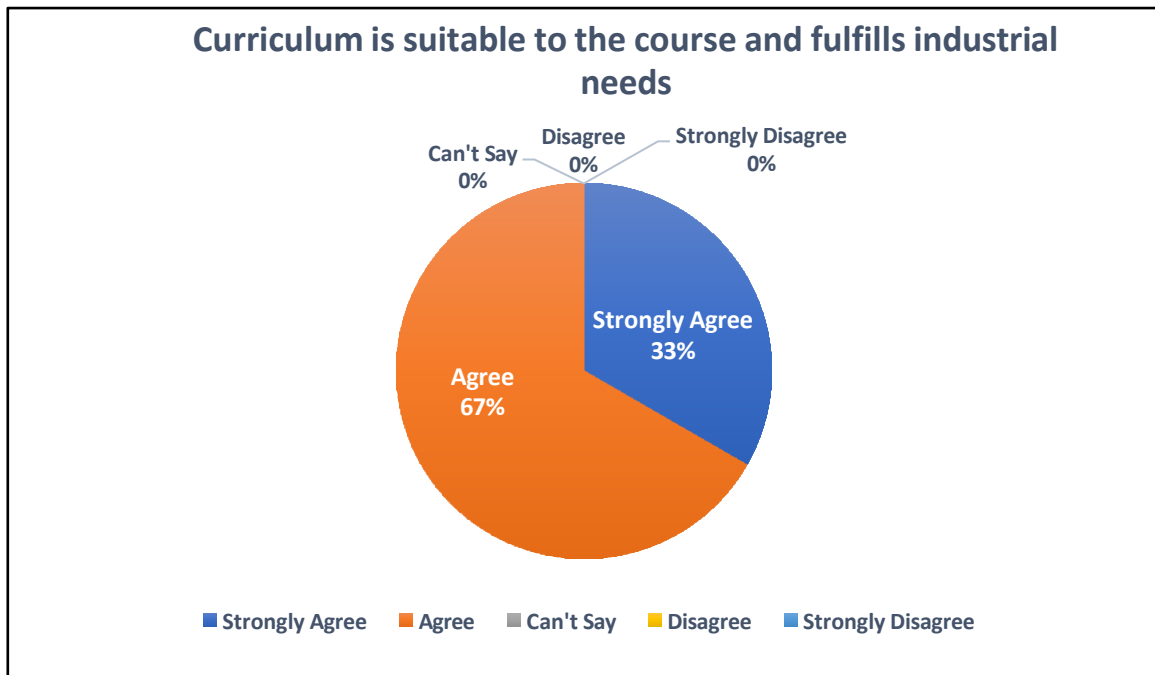

Step 2: Collection of data using Google form from Students of all programs.

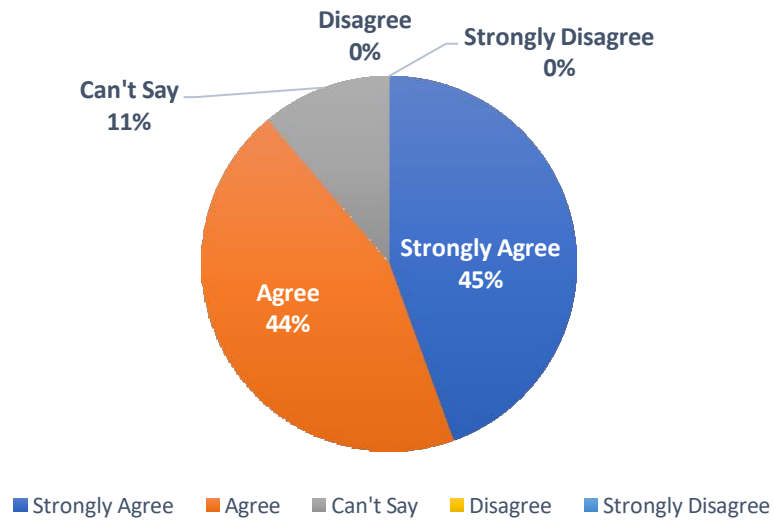
Step 3: Analysis of data - Calculation of Weighted Average Rating indicating attainment of each graduate attribute.

Step 4: Diagrammatic Representation of the rating on a scale of 1- 5 for each attribute.

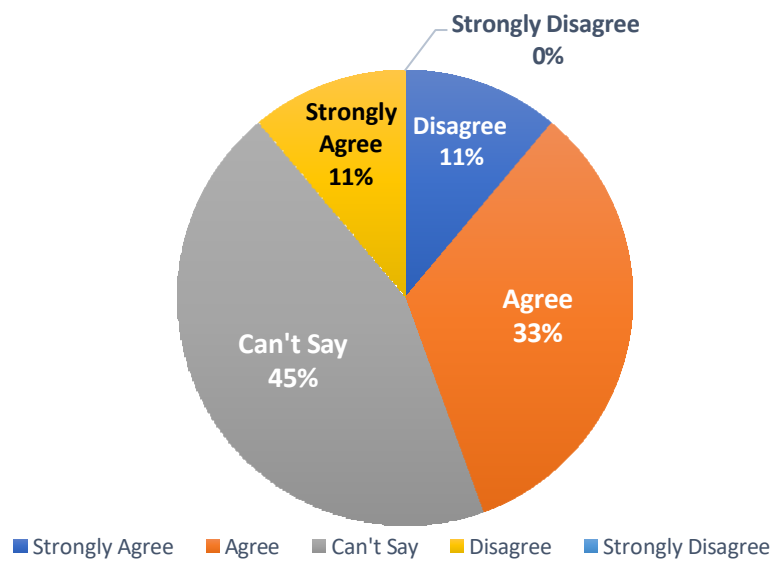
Distribution of respondents indicating extent of agreement towards attainment of graduate attributes



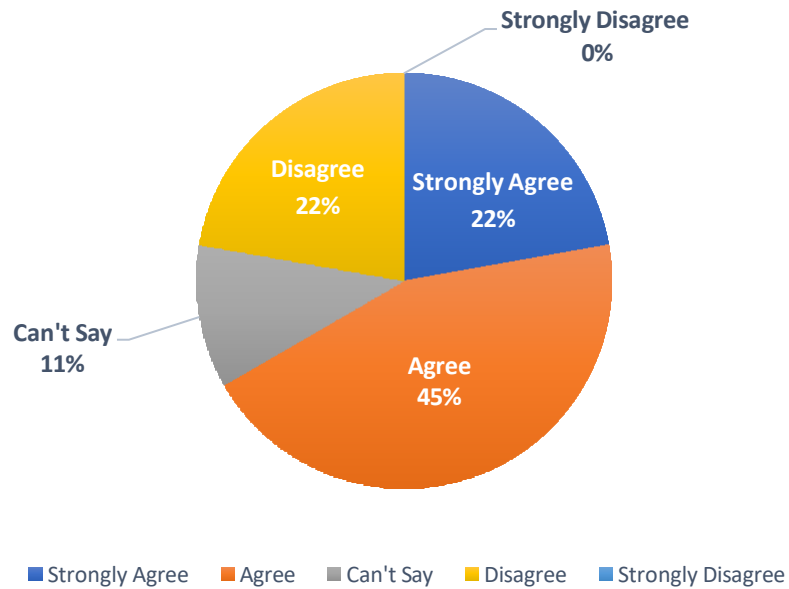
Curriculum has prospects for higher education and employment



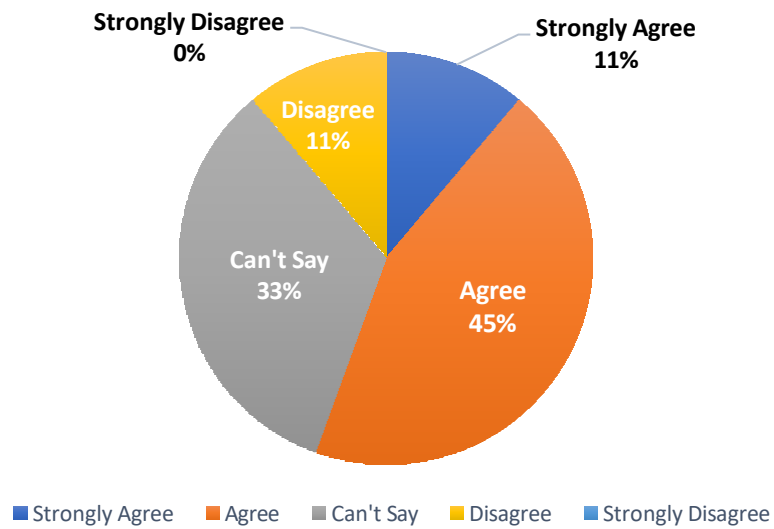
Curriculum makes the student competent in the field chosen



Curriculum promotes internship, research and field visits



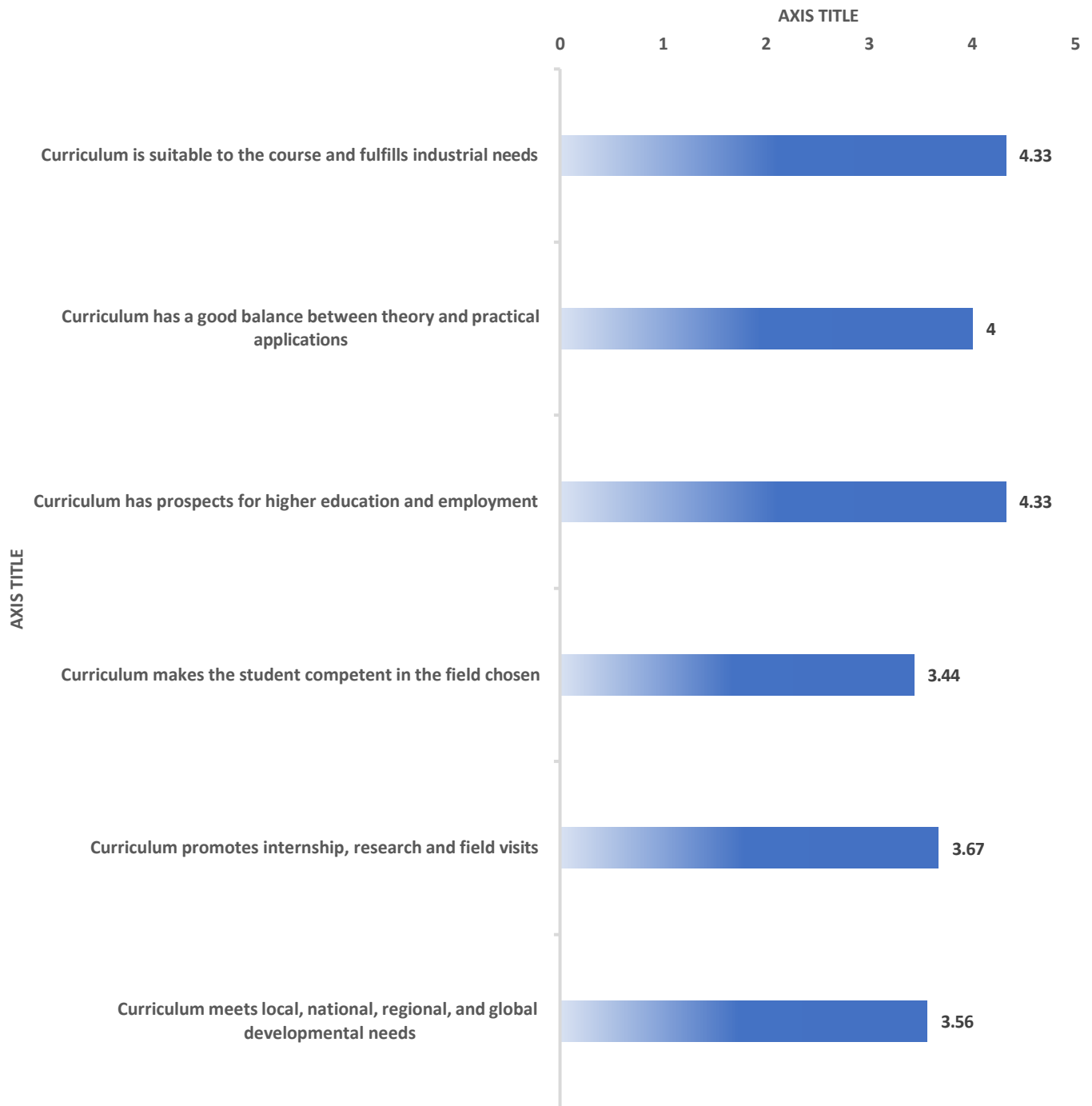
Curriculum meets local, national, regional, and global developmental needs
