**Brief summary of the activity:**

Department of Zoology, mLAC in collaboration with WWF had organised a field visit for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester M.Sc. Zoology students as a part of their laboratory course curriculum on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2024 from 7.30 am to 12.30 pm at Kadugodi Tree Park, Bangalore. The visit started with an introduction about the wildlife, biodiversity and their importance. They made the students aware of different fauna, and their adaptations to the environment. Different arthropods, and annelids and their morphological adaptation viz camouflage and mimicry for survival also were described. The naturalist explained the concept of "Insect Hotel", a structure made to give shelter to solitary insects. An introduction about bird watching was also given. They also briefed the students about career building opportunities as naturalists with WWF.

The visit ended by vote of thanks by Ms. Bhavya B, HoD, Department of Zoology to the resource persons. Students gave positive feedback about the visit and they submitted a report on the same as a part of their course curriculum.

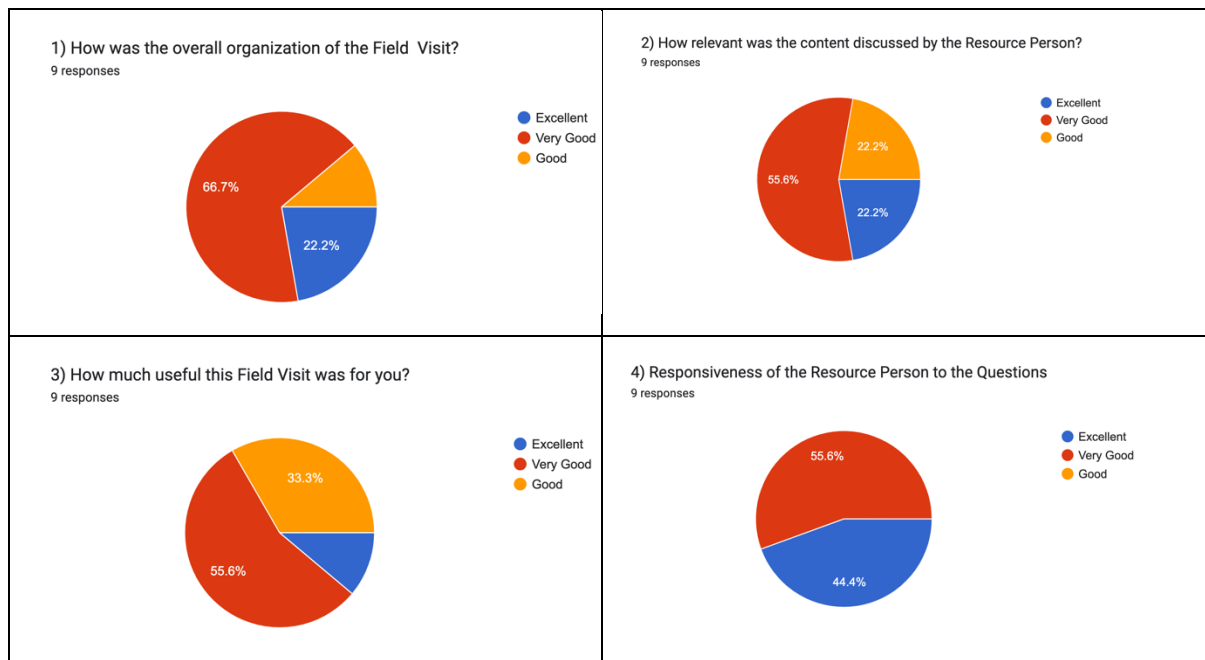
