




About the speakers:

EXHIBITION OF LANTANA ELEPHANT

Date -26/2/2024 to 02/03/2024

Venue- mLAC

Department of Zoology in association with World wildlife Fund (WWF) hosted exhibition of Lantana Elephant in the college campus from 26/2/2024 to 02/03/2024 in order to create awareness on co-existence.

Lantana Elephants – life-size models of Elephants made out of Lantana camara, an invasive weed that restricts the growth of indigenous vegetation was displayed in the campus in a bid to spread awareness on Coexistence. These eco-friendly creations are made with a toxic plant called Lantana from the forest. The local artists gathered Lantana stems and built life –size elephants with them. A team of 6 takes 45 days to build each sculpture. They're installed across Bangalore to promote peace between human and animals.


The management, principal, Staff and students appreciated the department for this initiative and also took photos with the Lantana Elephant.




1) How was the overall organization of the lecture?







