The first session of Mehendi art happened on 16th July 2022 in BT lab. The session started with the basics of the Mehendi making.




Brief summary of the activity:

Feedback analysis: The students found it a great opportunity to learn some basics of stitching. The feedback details have been furnished.





MUSHROOM CULTIVATION FACILITY

Mushroom is high in protein and thus it is being given due importance in many developed countries. If we use a hectare of land to produce beef, the yield of protein is about 80 kg/hectare, but if we grow mushrooms, the protein yield is commonly 80,000 kg/ha.
