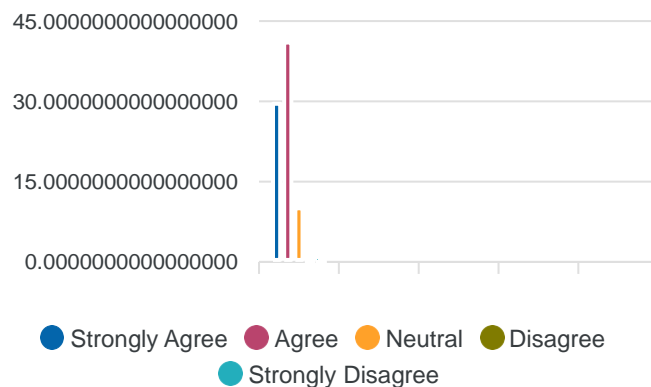

Step 2: Collection of data using Google form from Students of all programs

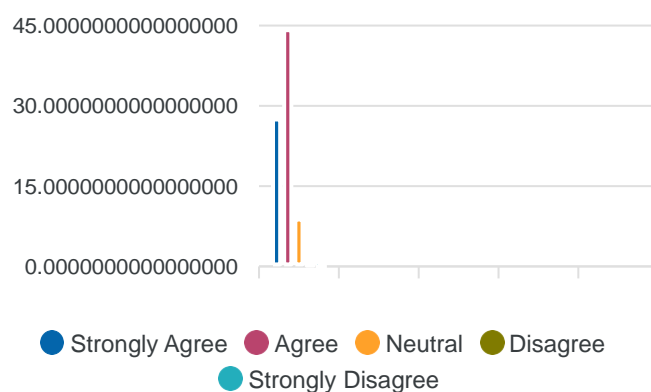
Step 3: Analysis of data - Calculation of Weighted Average Rating indicating attainment of each graduate attribute.

Step 4: Diagrammatic Representation of the rating on a scale of 1- 5 for each attribute.

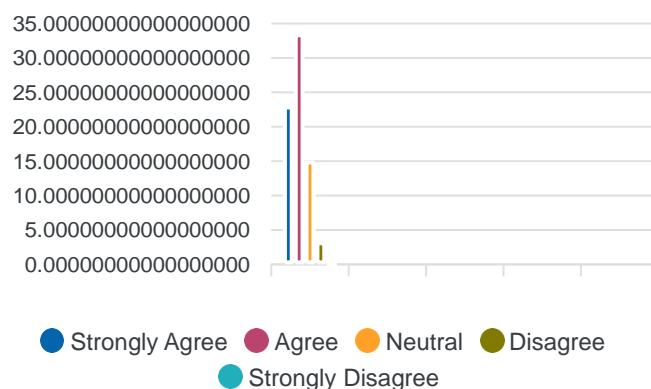

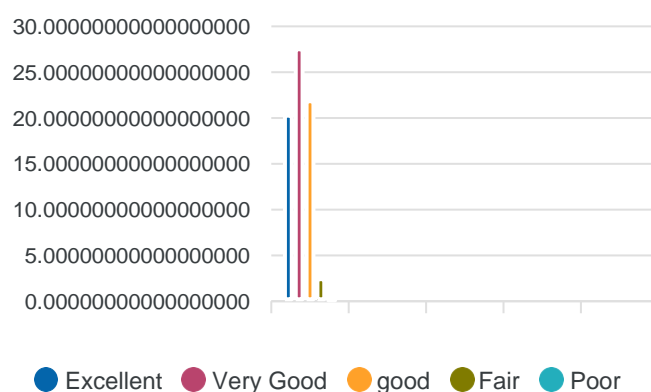

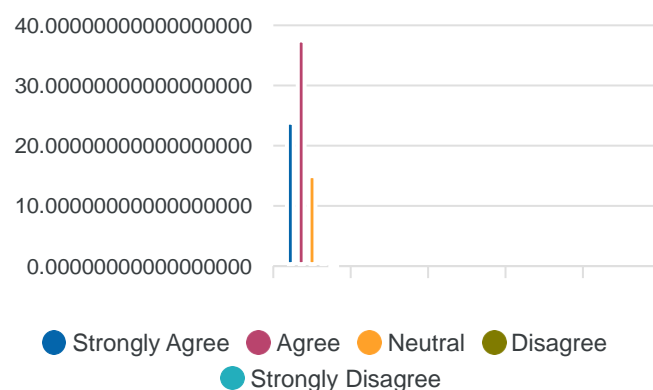

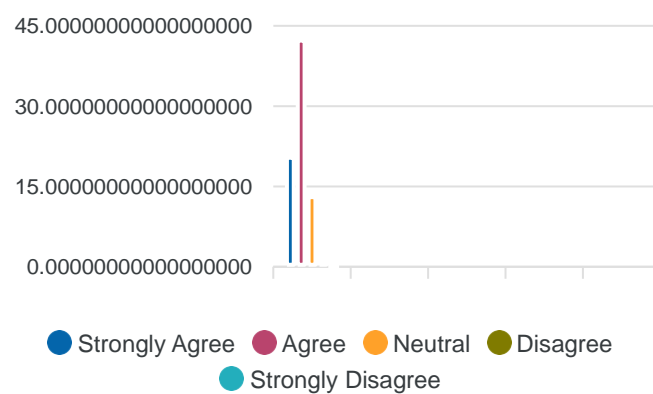

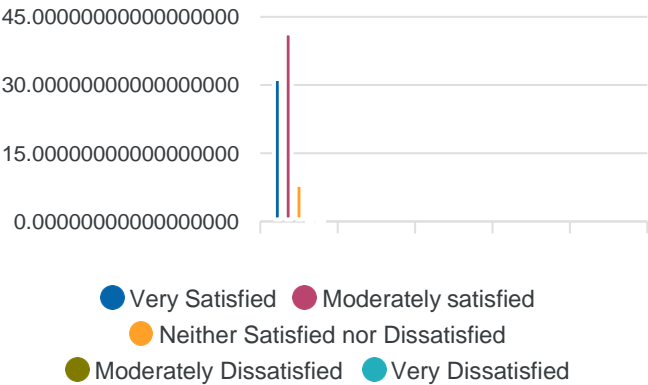

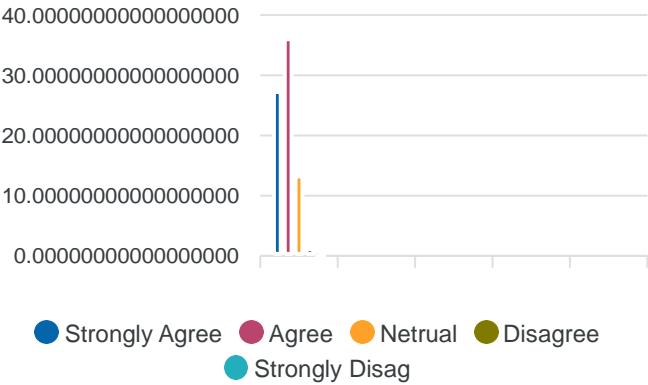

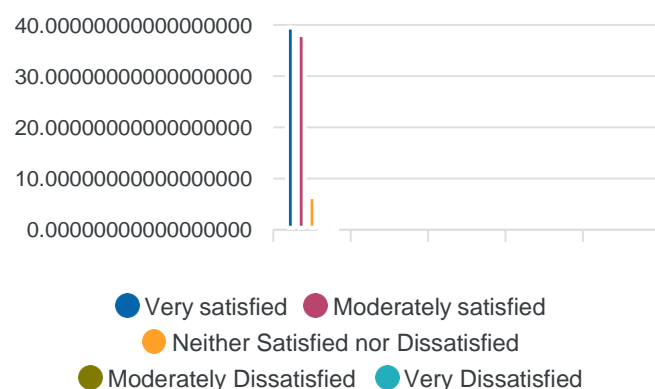

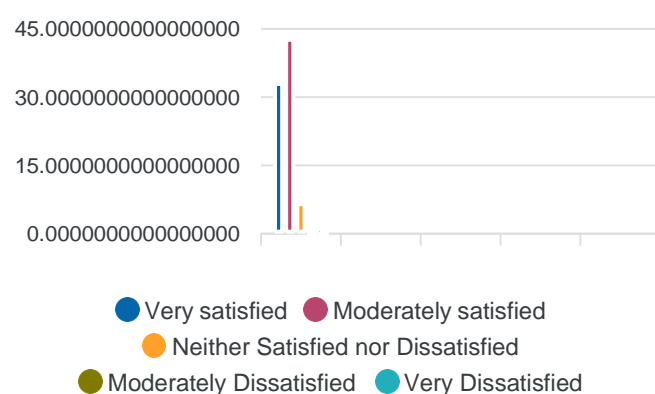

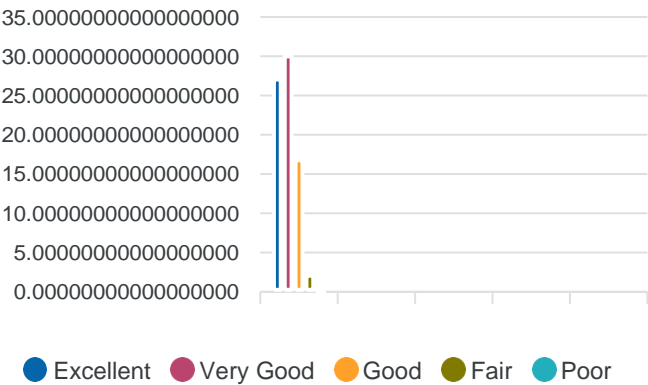
