Objectives:

Methodology:

Step 1: Framing of a structured questionnaire on a 5-point scale

Step 2: Collection of data from teaching faculty

Step 3: Analysis of data - Calculation of Weighted Average Rating indicating the impact of faculty development programs on a scale of 1 to 5 (5 – indicating impact to a very large extent and 1 – indicating no impact at all)

Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs) during the academic year 2020-21. The following is a list of FDPs attended by you, classified on the basis of expected outcomes:











Overall Rating = 3.97

It is observed that the impact of FDPs for all parameters has been rated in the range of 3.84 to 4.07, indicating that the expected outcomes have been attained 'to a very large extent'. It may be noted that the rating for Personal Development and Career Development has exceeded '4' indicating that the teaching faculty have been provided opportunities for their progression
